The on-site Museum offers an introductory film on the history and archaeological investigations that led to the preservation and nomination of this site as a National Historic Landmark. The Museum contains dioramas and displays of the archaeology and reconstruction of the site as well as collections of the artifacts discovered. Within the village, you are free to browse through several houses and a surrounding stockade that have been reconstructed in the exact locations where archaeologists discovered evidence of these structures from the 13th century habitation.
